About the course

They say that the eyes are the window to the soul, and this course is focusing completely on makeup techniques of the eyes. You will learn about different eye shapes makeup products and brushes and how to select makeup looks

according to eye shape, occasion and dress. You will gain confidence in applying glitters and false eyelashes; strip lashes, magnetic lashes and individual lashes. You will practice with different styles of eyeliners, how to apply gel, liquid and pen liners.

This course is part of our specialist course offer in the beauty subject, designed to support our learners to build makeup skills for professional and personal development. To do this course, you should have the foundation skills for makeup artistry, either through completion of our beginners course or from other experience. After completing this course, you can enrol on a progression course with us to gain more confidence in your technical skills.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Identify different eye shapes and design makeup looks accordingly
- Shape eyebrows with the use of makeup
- Select suitable lashes for different makeup Looks
- Create different looks of eyeliners, for example wing, Arabic or thin liner.
- Apply strip and individual false eyelashes with glue, and magnetic lashes (without glue)
- Prepare and use makeup and application tools in a hygienic and safe manner
- Clean and store makeup and application tools in a hygienic and appropriate manner

What are the entry requirements?

- Basic knowledge of makeup is needed for this course.
- We use Google Suite for Education to record your learning journey. If you are a new learner with us, we will create an account for you. Details will be sent to your personal email so please check your inbox and spam regularly prior to course start.

What do I need to bring with me?

- For health and safety reasons, you will be asked to bring your own makeup and equipment:
 - Foundation(liquid)
 - o Eyeshadow palette, with dark and light colours and glitter shadows
 - o Transparent/fixing powder and blusher
 - Lipstick, lipliner, lip gloss
 - Mascara, eyeliner (gel/liquid), eyebrow pencil/gel
 - o False eyelashes: Strip, individual and magnetic
 - Eye water line pencil (white and black)
 - Glitter for the eyes
 - Mirror with stand
 - Moisturizer
 - Wipes, cotton buds/pads or wool balls
- Note: No need to buy expensive new makeup. High street brands are fine, and you can bring your own everyday makeup and use it.
 - If you have questions or are unsure, your tutor can advise you in the first session.
- You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes

How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend. If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.
