About the Course

Awareness of domestic abuse and its impact is important for those working in a wide range of sectors such as healthcare, social care, childcare, education, and housing. There is a need to understand the issues, report on those who may be at risk and support signposting to relevant services.

This 35-week qualification is designed to increase learners' awareness and understanding of domestic abuse and its impact. The need for education and training across sectors to enable identification of abuse, allocation of support and referral is a recurring theme within regional domestic abuse strategies.

- Understand domestic abuse.
- Understand the signs and risk factors associated with domestic abuse.
- Understands the impact of domestic abuse.
- Understand policy, response, and intervention in relation to domestic abuse.

Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

- You will need an initial assessment, where we will ask you to complete some tasks.
- We will also ask you some questions to be able to support you better with your studies.
- You need to have writing skills at English Level 1 or above.
- You will need internet access and an electronic device.
