Course Title: ESOL E1 Writing Fee:

Level and Qualification: Ascentis ESOL Skills for Life (Writing) (Entry 1) (QCF) (by exam)

Start Date: September 2020 End Date: February 2021

Course Length: 2 sessions per week over 16 weeks (AM or PM or Eve)

Or a 3 hour session per week on Saturdays over 16 weeks.

Time: (1.5 hour Live session on Google Meet and 30 minutes in Google Classroom for questions, feedback and assignments)

You will track your progress by accessing your online learning plan (ILP), at the start and at the end of the course. You will respond to questions and feedback in the Google Classroom. You will build a portfolio to provide the evidence necessary to achieve the qualification. There is approximately 1-2 hours of homework per week.

By the end of the course you will be able to:

- Access your learning through Google Classroom
- Develop your study skills
- Become aware of your strengths and areas for development
- Improve your basic writing skills.
- Gain a better understanding of filling in simple forms and writing simple sentences.
- Cover basic spelling, punctuation and grammar.

What is required to attend the course?

- Access to internet with camera and microphone.
- You must know how to independently access Google Suite Apps access to a Chrome Browser or Download Phone Apps to access Google Meet, Google Classroom and Google Docs.
