What is needed for the course?

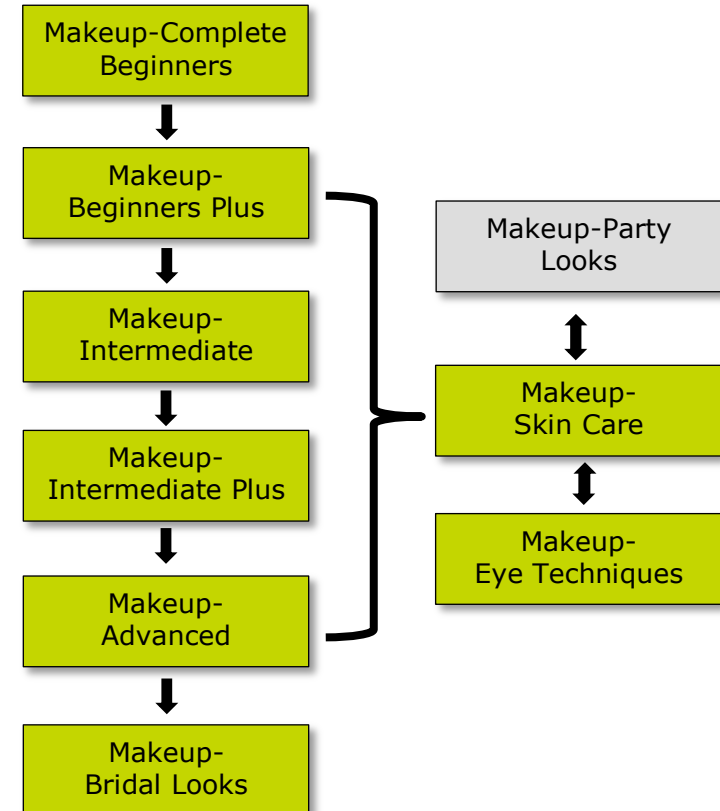
For health and safety reasons, you will be asked to bring your own makeup and equipment which include:

- Mirror with stand (preferable with light)
- Makeup brushes set (bring your own or you can buy from amazon)
- Foundation (liquid)
- Concealer and colour corrector.
- Eyeshadow palette, with dark and light colours and glitters
- Transparent/fixing powder and blusher
- Lipstick, lipliner, lip gloss
- Mascara, eyeliner (gel/liquid), eyebrow pencil/gel
- Moisturiser
- Wipes, cotton buds/pads or wool balls
