What will happen on the course?

This course is for the absolute beginner who would like to try working with glass. You will receive a good foundation in practising safe glass cutting to create a flat glass design of your own. You will carry out research for your design and experiment with practising cutting and nibbling glass safely to create different shapes.

You will track your progress by accessing your online learning plan (ILP), at the start, during and at the end of the course.

By the end of the course you will be able to:

- Follow health and safety guidelines to demonstrate cutting glass safely in the studio
- Cut glass into straight, triangular, wavy and round shapes
- Carry out research to make your own glass fusion design

- Please wear suitable clothing closed toe shoes are required
