About the course

The intent of this qualification is to support learners to progress into employment in the Creative Media Industry or onto further qualifications at Level 3 within the field.

What will I learn?

The qualification consists of the following units:

- Plan and produce work to a design brief
 - Directing for film and television
 - Editing for film and television
 - Multi-camera production
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What are the entry requirements?

- Good level of literacy to be able to produce written assignments
 - Good Digital Skills
 - There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However, learners may find it helpful if they've already completed a basic non accredited community learning photography or video editing course.
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What equipment do I need for the course?

- For this course you will need a video camera with microphone and Adobe Premiere Pro. The centre can lend you the equipment and softer required to complete the qualification but **please note** that we would not be able to provide you with the equipment for your own camera as the equipment we have might be different to the ones suitable for your own camera. We will give you more information about the above at the Initial Assessment. 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How will my learning be assessed?

- You work will be assessed through a portfolio of evidence
 - Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.
 - This qualification is internally and externally (by an EQA from NCFE) quality assured.
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Devices and digital applications required for online courses

As part of this course is online, access to a computer or a laptop and a good internet connection is required. We recommend that you download Google Chrome Browser.
