- Use and care for jewellery making tools in a healthy and safe manner.

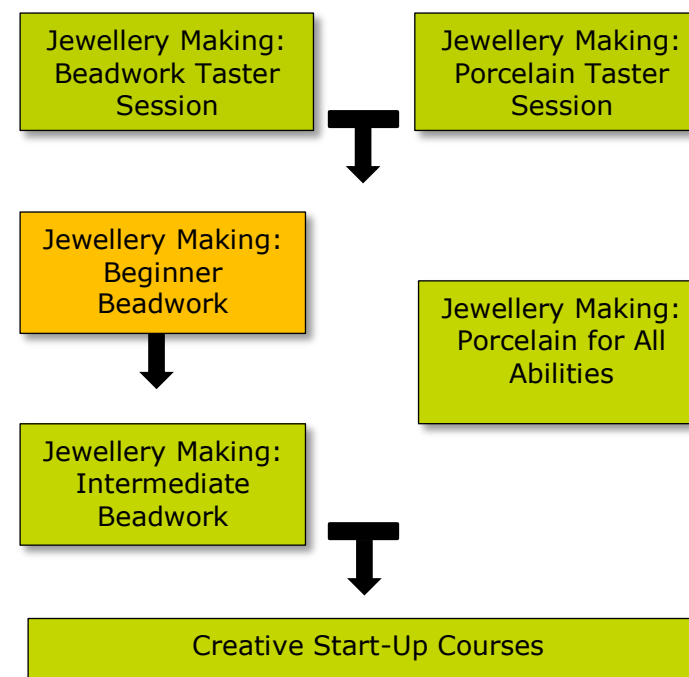
