On this course you will further your knowledge about different beads and techniques that are used to make jewellery. You will design your own pieces of jewellery, such as necklaces or bracelets, using more advanced techniques, including wirework skills.

The course is suitable for those who have already completed **Jewellery Making: Beginner Beadwork**.

After completing this course, you might wish to progress to one of our creative start-up courses to learn how to turn your creative hobby into an income stream, or our other available jewellery courses.

- Select and use beading wire, thread, crimps, and clasps for a jewellery design.
- Demonstrate safe use of essential tools, including needles, pliers and cutters.
- Create a finished piece from your own design.


