

## Pottery Wheel for Beginners

### About the Course

This course is a part of our Pottery Specialist Programmes aimed at those who would like to learn pottery skills and techniques to pursue a career in Pottery or other related sectors within Creative Industries.

This course is for complete beginners and there are no specific entry requirements although some experience of using clay would be an advantage or completed pottery complete beginners-taster session

### Course Learning Outcomes

- Practice preparing clay, wedging & recycling
- Gain skills in the fundamental throwing techniques eg. centring, opening out and pulling up
- Explore throwing a range of shapes but focusing mostly on cylinders
- Demonstrate awareness of health and safety within the pottery studio

### What is needed for the course?

For health and safety reasons, you will be asked to bring your 3M Graded face mask. Please note you will **not** be allowed to complete any glazing if you do not have your own 3m graded face mask within the lesson or wear gloves provided
