*If you are unemployed, looking for work, and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to sign a self-declaration form stating that you are looking for a job and provide supporting evidence.

*If you are in low paid employment and you earn less than £10.85p/h or £21,157.59 annual gross salary, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.

About the course

This course is a part of our Floristry Specialist Programmes aimed at those who would like to learn Floristry skills and techniques to pursue a career in the industry or other related sectors within the Creative Industries.

Our Floristry Specialist Programmes offer both accredited (qualification) and not-accredited (non-qualification) courses up to L2 (GSCE equivalent).

This course is for complete beginners and there are no specific entry requirements although some experience of flower arranging would be an advantage.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Use floristry material and equipment in a safe way
- Make a posy flower arrangement
- Make a linear flower display
- Make a horizontal flower arrangement

What are the entry requirements?

What do I need to bring with me?

- You will need to provide your own flowers to create arrangements. Your tutor will advise you on this in the first session.
- Essential materials and equipment are included and will be made available to you to use dooring the course

• You may wish to bring a paper pad and a pen to take notes

How will my learning be assessed?

You will build your own digital portfolio of work.

Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. **Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend.** If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.
