- Generate a bank of games/resources to use with your child to promote maths in everyday life.

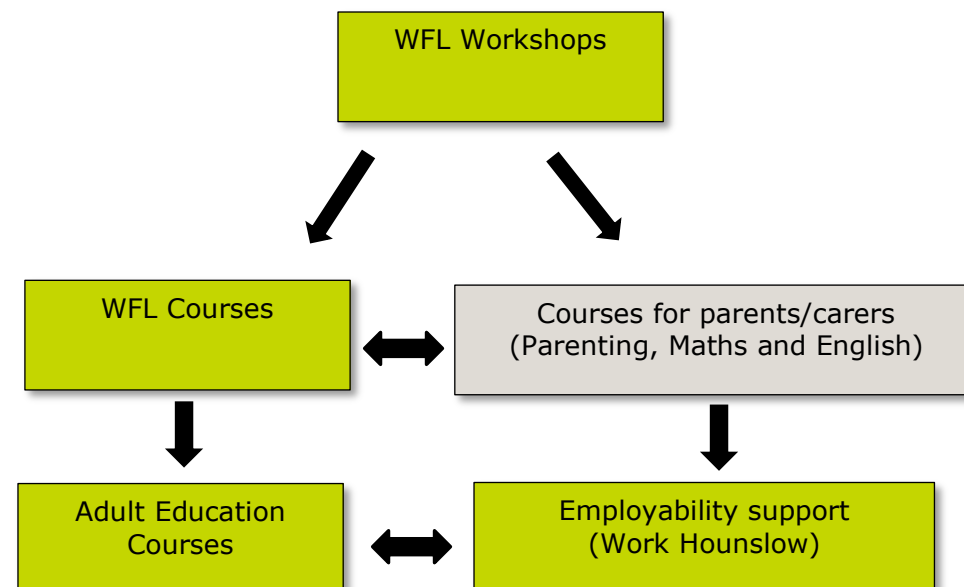
