**If you are unemployed, looking for work, and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to sign a self-declaration form stating that you are looking for a job and provide supporting evidence.*

**If you are in low paid employment and you earn less than £10.85p/h or £21,157.59 annual gross salary, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.*

About the course

This course is part of our creative specialist programme designed to enable learners to develop their practice in textiles and applied arts. Once you have completed this course you are recommended to continue your learning on one of our weaving progression courses to gain confidence and skills for an independent weaving practice. You could also progress on the Level 2 Qualification in Creative Crafts Textiles to embark on a professional pathway.

You will receive the guidance on how to set up, prepare and get started with your loom, and be mentored along the way.

On this course you will receive an introduction to the essential use of a loom in the making of different types of fabrics. You will be encouraged to explore materials, pattern and structure to gain practical knowledge of the great possibilities of woven textile design.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Set up and prepare a rigid heddle loom independently
- Complete, take off and tidy up your weaving from the rigid heddle loom independently
- Operate a prepared rigid heddle loom, and design through making to create at least one woven piece or product
- Finish the edges of a woven piece of fabric, by sewing or making decorative knots and tassles
- Name the tools and techniques that are involved in basic handloom weaving
- Use and care for a rigid heddle loom in a safe and healthy manner

What are the entry requirements?

- This course is open for confident beginners, but we recommend that you have completed a Weaving on the loom introduction course with us, or have some prior textile craft experience.
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What do I need to bring with me?

- Essential resources will be provided but you will need to arrange for some of your weaving materials, especially if you make more than one piece.
 - You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes
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How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. **Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend.** If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.

What can I do after completing this course?

- The most obvious step after completing this course would be to progress on to another weaving course where you will learn to set up and prepare the loom, to become independent in your weaving practice, or a weaving masterclass course to expand your material knowledge.
