

Photography: Places

About the Course

This is a beginners course in **photographing places and environments**. The course introduces learners to the fundamentals of capturing landscapes, cityscapes, and local spaces through photography. Learners will explore composition techniques, lighting, perspective, and visual storytelling to effectively document different locations. They will learn how to plan and carry out on-location photo shoots, select and edit their strongest images, and produce a small photography zine featuring at least five original photographs of places captured during the course.


Course Learning Outcomes

- Demonstrate an understanding of composition, lighting, and perspective when photographing a range of indoor and outdoor locations.
- Plan and carry out a location-based photo shoot, producing a selection of technically competent and visually engaging images of places.
- Edit and curate a series of photographs to create a cohesive mini zine that communicates a clear sense of place.

What is needed for the course

- There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this course. However, learners may find it helpful if they've already complete a complete beginners course, photography portraits course or any photography course
