



Pottery Make to Sell: Wheel Throwing

About the Course

This course is a hands-on, real-world ceramics course designed for both complete beginners and more experienced potters. Learners will create a variety of products on the pottery wheel, developing skills in throwing, trimming, glazing, and decoration, before preparing their finished pieces for sale. The course concludes with the opportunity to sell work at Belle Square during Hounslow Market on 8th July. All pieces made on the course will be taken to the market to be sold, and learners will keep any money they make. If any work does not sell on the day, it will be returned to its maker. Alongside practical making skills, participants will also explore pricing strategies, branding, and stall display ideas to ensure their products are market-ready. This course offers a valuable opportunity to experience both producing and selling handmade pottery in a live market setting

Course Learning Outcomes

- **Create a variety of** functional pieces using wheel-throwing, trimming, and glazing techniques for example a bowl
- **Apply** effective pricing strategies to prepare pottery work for sale in a real market setting.
