Please note: To successfully complete this workshop you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

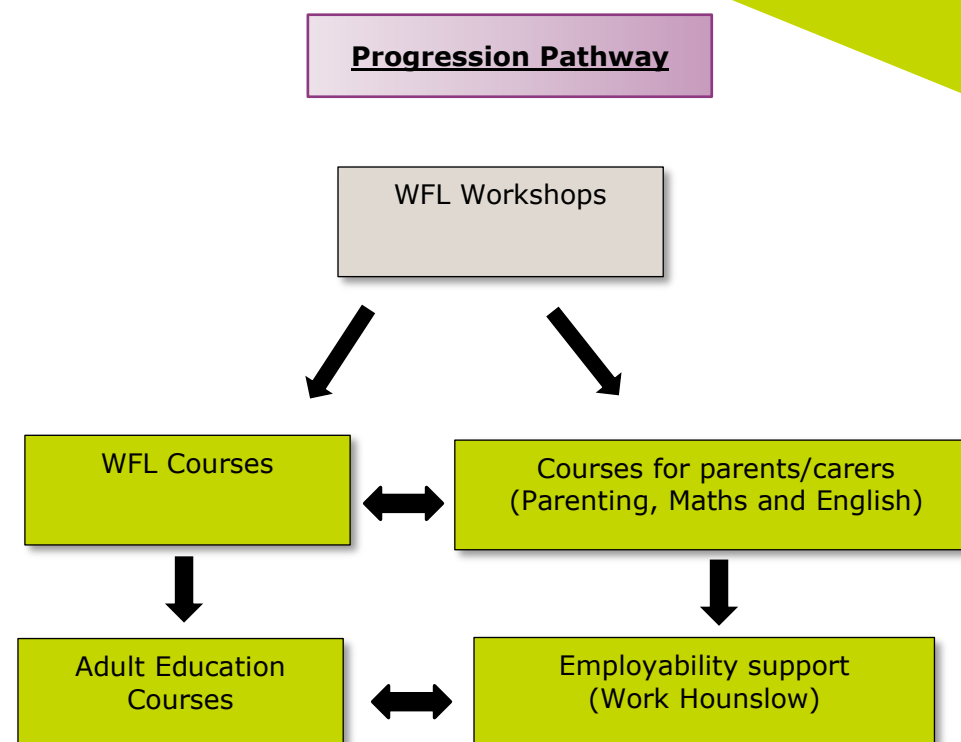
What is needed for the course?
