

Cybersecurity Level 2 Award

About the course

This qualification course will help you extend on the skills learned in the Cybersecurity Level 1 course.

You will research the internal and external threats to systems and data from employees and unauthorised users. You will explore IT system vulnerabilities that hackers could exploit. You will learn security measures to protect IT systems and data from current and future threats. You will have the opportunity to design and create a user access control system to restrict unauthorised access. You will be able to explain how ethical hacking can be used to protect an IT system or network.

At the end of the course, you will have created a portfolio of evidence which will be assessed to obtain the qualification.

By the end of the course you will be able to:


- Describe the types of threat to IT systems and data.
