# About the course

The overarching aim of this qualification is to help learners to develop their skills knowledge and understanding of the creative craft processes in textile. Learners will then be able to progress into employment in the Creative Art Industry (Floristry in particular ) or onto further qualifications at Level 3 in art & design and craft.

\*If you are unemployed, looking for work, and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to sign a self-declaration form stating that you are looking for a job and provide supporting evidence.

\*If you are in low paid employment and you earn less than £10.85p/h or £21,157.59 annual gross salary, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.

# What will I learn?

# The qualification consists of the following units:

- Use materials, tools and equipment to develop craft techniques
- Investigate creative enterprise and employment opportunities in the textile industry
- Develop textile ideas
- Create, present and evaluate final textile item

#### What are the entry requirements?

- Good level of literacy to be able to produce written assignments
- Good Digital Skills
- There are no specific recommended prior learning requirements for this qualification. However, learners may find it helpful if they've already completed a basic non accredited community learning course or have achieved a Level 1 Textile qualification.

# What do I need to bring with me?

- The learners will do their practical work in our Art Studio and the main basic materials and resources will be provided by the centre so you can learn the requires skills and techniques. However, you may wish to bring your own fabric to create your own unique designs.
- Please wear closed toe shoes

- You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes

# How will my learning be assessed?

• You work will be assessed through a portfolio of evidence

- Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.
- This qualification is quality assured internally and externally (by an EQA from NCFE).
