About the course

The course is designed to support you to grow as an artist and entrepreneur. You will gain craft knowledge from experienced tutors and receive the essential skills for promoting your own handcrafted designs commercially. After completion of the course you will be given a platform to sell your items at the Design & Made in Hounslow markets and pop-up shops at no cost; A real life experience of trading at craft fairs.

Porcelain is one of the most beautiful clays you can work with. With its white and transparent qualities and its refined smooth texture, it makes for a perfect material for jewellery making. You will learn how to craft delicate

jewellery pieces from simple forms to more elaborate shapes and will be guided through different methods of surface decorations and glazes. You will discover the beauty of porcelains and the fun techniques to create your own original jewellery pieces such as pendants, earrings and broches.

What will I learn?

(Learning Outcomes)

- Learn about Porcelain as a material and its origins
 - Craft simple forms and discover some elaborate shapes to make pendants, earrings and broches
 - Learn techniques on underglaze hand painting and painting with oxides
 - How to use transparent glaze to finish jewellery pieces
 - Price and label your crafted products
 - Display and trade your handmade work at markets

How will my learning be assessed?
