<sup>\*</sup>If you are unemployed, looking for work, and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to sign a self-declaration form stating that you are looking for a job and provide supporting evidence.

#### About the course

<sup>\*</sup>If you are in low paid employment and you earn less than £10.85p/h or £21,157.59 annual gross salary, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.

This course is part of our creative arts programme designed for learners to develop their skills in a specialist art subject. It is suitable for both beginners and learners with some painting experience, who wish to focus on the watercolour medium. Once you have completed this course you might decide to continue learning painting techniques at our creative programmes to gain more confidence so to start practising more independently.

On this course you will learn how to apply loose and free flow techniques to watercolour paintings. You will explore wet-in-wet techniques and colour compositions and complete at least one painting per session. The themes will be varied and suggested by the tutor.

#### What will I learn?

#### After this course you will be able to:

- Prepare your workspace with appropriate materials and equipment for free flow water colour painting
- Employ colour theory to mix colours cleanly
- Laying watercolour washes and working wet-in-wet
- Complete a quick watercolour painting within each session, that makes use of the techniques you are learning
- Apply health and safety when using and cleaning up tools and equipment after a painting session.

### What are the entry requirements?

- This course is for beginners to watercolour painting techniques, with or without prior art skills
- We use Google Suite for Education to record your learning journey. If you are a new learner with us, we will create an account for you. Details will be sent to your personal email so please check your inbox and spam regularly prior to course start.

### What do I need to bring with me?

- Essential tools and materials will be provided
- You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes

### How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend. If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.

# What can I do after completing this course?

The most obvious progression pathways after this course are:

- continue learning on our watercolour specialist programmes to gain more confidence so to be able to work more independently
