Sewing: Introduction to the

Sewing Machine for Complete Beginners

About the Course

On this course you will receive a thorough introduction to the technical functions of a sewing machine, learn how to care for it and use its basic functions. You will also learn how to use other equipment so as to achieve great results when sewing. You will mainly be doing exercises and completing sewing samples and will get the chance to apply your learning in one small project.

Course Learning Outcomes

- Identify the different parts and functions of a sewing machine
- Thread and spool a sewing machine
- Use straight, zig-zag and backward stitches
- Stitch the 4 fundamental seams on a sewing machine; Plain, Flat-Felled, French and Lapped
- Use and care for the sewing machine and other tools and equipment in a healthy and safe manner. Tools include scissors, measuring tape, pins, needles, unpicker, iron and pressing tools, tailors' chalk.


