**If you are unemployed, looking for work, and are in receipt of a means tested benefit, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to sign a self-declaration form stating that you are looking for a job and provide supporting evidence.*

**If you are in low paid employment and you earn less than £10.85p/h or £21,157.59 annual gross salary, you do not have to pay the course fees. You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.*

About the course

This course will teach you everything you need to know to get started with makeup applications for parties and special occasions. You will explore a range of party makeup products and learn how to select products according to your skin, their application and your desired look. The course is aimed at providing you a hands-on experience with party makeup for weddings and other occasions, and build your confidence in daring applications.

This course is part of our specialist course offer in the beauty subject, designed to support our learners to build makeup skills for professional and personal development. This is a masterclass, and some prior experience is expected. The long-term aim would be to go into the beauty sector as a professional pathway. After completing this course, you can enrol on a progression course with us to gain more confidence in your technical skills.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Prepare and use makeup and application tools in a hygienic and safe manner
- Clean and store makeup and application tools in a hygienic and appropriate manner
- Create various evening eye makeup looks for parties (Smokey eyes, spotlight eye).
- Apply glitters and pigments
- Select and use dark coloured lipsticks
- Create makeup party looks for special occasions, for example weddings

What are the entry requirements?

- To enrol on this course, you should have some prior experience of makeup artistry
 - We use Google Suite for Education to record your learning journey. If you are a new learner with us, we will create an account for you. Details will be sent to your personal email so please check your inbox and spam regularly prior to course start.
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What do I need to bring with me?

- For health and safety reasons, you will be asked to bring your own makeup and equipment:
 - A set of basic makeup brushes
 - Primer, foundation(liquid)
 - Concealer
 - Eyeshadow palette, and glitter
 - Transparent/fixing powder and blusher
 - Dark coloured lipstick, lipliner
 - Mascara, eyeliner (gel/liquid)
 - Mirror with stand
 - Moisturizer
 - Cleansing lotion
 - Wipes, cotton buds/pads or wool balls
 - ***Note: No need to buy expensive new makeup. High street brands are fine, and you can bring your own everyday makeup and use it.***
If you have questions or are unsure, your tutor can advise you in the first session.
 - You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes
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How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. **Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend.** If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.

What can I do after completing this course?

- The most obvious pathway after this course, would be to seek further learning such as qualifications in makeup and beauty, to qualify for a professional career
