- Learn hand-building techniques such as pinching, building with soft slabs and coiling.

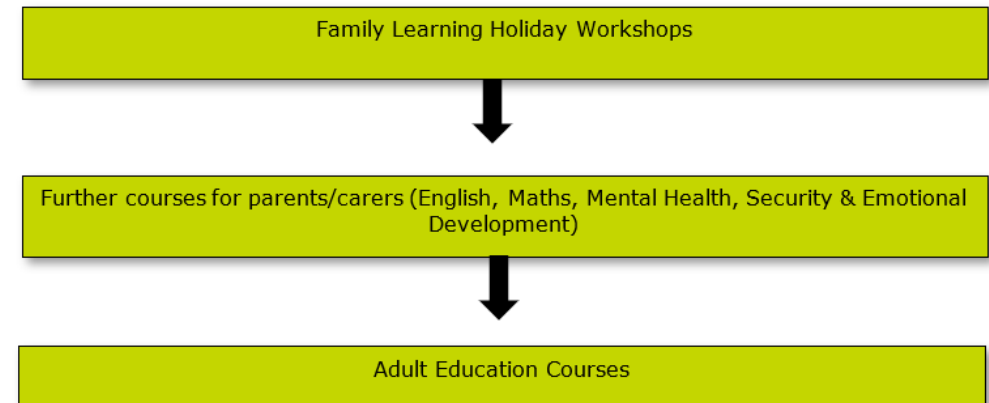
Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.
