

# **MS Office Intermediate**

#### **About the course**

If you have completed our MS Office (Basics) course; passed the Essential Digital Skills Level 1 course or have used MS Office before, this course is for you.

You will improve your knowledge and skills on the 3 main popular MS Office applications: Word, Excel and PowerPoint.

You will learn how to create a variety of documents like templates, agendas and memos. With Excel, you will learn how to apply different formulae and functions, and also, visualise your data. You will also learn how to create presentations by applying different graphics, transition and animation in PowerPoint.

#### **Course Learning Outcomes**

- Use Microsoft Word
  - to create a range of documents
  - to use templates
  - create and edit tables and charts.
- Use Microsoft Excel
  - to enter more complex formulas and functions;
