Course Learning Outcomes

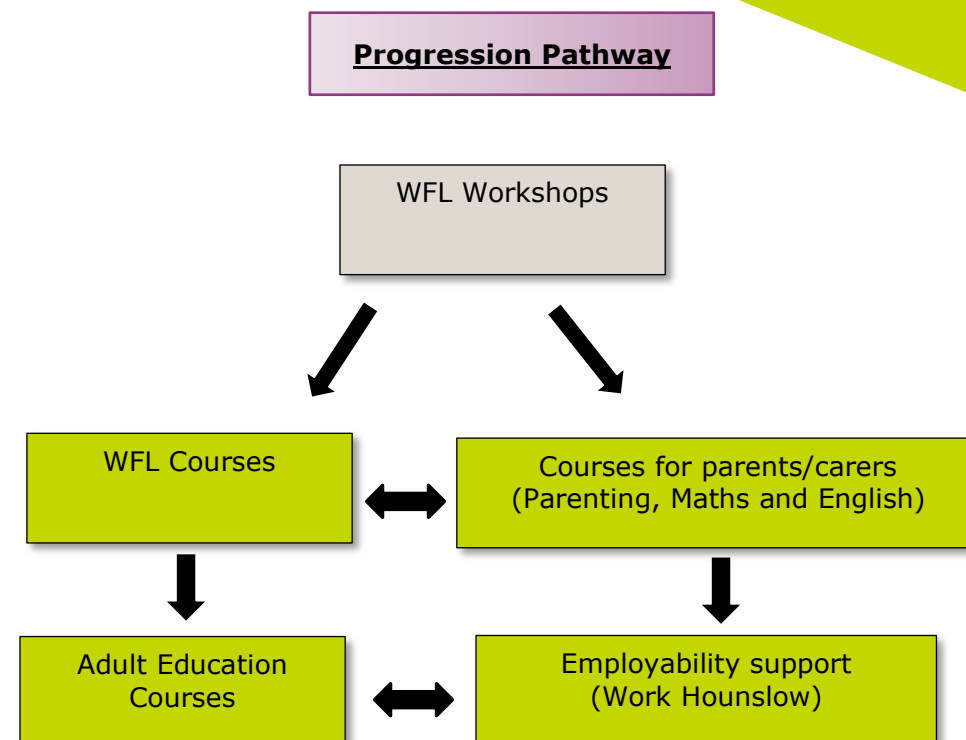
- Explain how engineering impacts our world
