About the course

Hounslow Adult & Community Education is producing a large-scale quilted art piece to thank and honour our key workers for their hard work during the pandemic. The quilt will be on public display, and it will be created on this course. There is an original design, but as part of the group you will be able to influence the final piece and be part of realising this historical project.

In the first session, the class will be introduced to the brief and the design template and start developing the design

through discussions and sketches. Together, the class will create the large-scale quilt with patchwork and applique – in which any textile techniques and materials can be used, crazy or traditional. The class relies on teamwork and collective knowledge, and will be guided by an expert tutor.

This course is part of our wellbeing programme designed to enable learners to try a new art, craft or exercise in order to explore the benefits they have our wellness. Once you have completed this course you might decide to join a local sewing group or continue your learning on our creative specialist programmes.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Work in a group to respond to the given brief of developing and producing a large scale quilt design from a small scale original
- Use applique and patchwork techniques for creative quilting
- Apply a variety of hand and machine stitches
- Work with consciousness to textiles and their qualities for use in public spaces

What are the entry requirements?

- There are no specific entry requirements to this course. It is open for learners with mixed levels of experience.

What do I need to bring with me?

- All resources will be provided
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How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal feedback to support your progression. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course. **Please note that the first session is an induction to the course and the centre, so it is therefore essential that you attend.** If you for any reason are unable to attend, please let us know and ensure that you read through the induction slides located in your Google Classroom and complete any related tasks.

What can I do after completing this course?

- The most obvious step after completing this course would be to progress on to a specialist course within the textile subject, for example weaving, sewing, or knitting. At the end of the course your tutor will advise you on your possible next steps.
