

Pottery Technician Course

About the Course

This course is for anyone who would like to gain more confidence in working within or running a pottery studio.

Understanding all the different equipment and materials that are used in a pottery studio and how to use them correctly. The health and safety practices technicians need to implement in their own studio or in a classroom/studio setting. You will be learning about different clays, glazes, firing & health and safety in a pottery studio/classroom.

Course Learning Outcomes

1. Identify the different equipment and materials that is used in the pottery studio and be able to use it safely
2. Develop your own glazes and be able to mix up glazes safely by using correct glazing methods
3. Compare different clays and what temperatures they need to be fired to and complete a bisk or glaze firing
