A really fun clay family lesson that can be enjoyed by all. You will be shown a range of techniques; pinching, building with soft slabs and coiling. Once you have mastered each technique you will get the opportunity to create their own abstract face shape trinket dish(the line art style that is really in trend at the moment), candle holders and a vase. This class will include a glazing session later on in the term.

What will I learn?

(Learning Outcomes)

- How to roll out a slab of clay and how to make your own slip
 - Learn hand-building techniques such as pinching, building with soft slabs and coiling
 - Using your new hand-building techniques to create your own abstract face shape trinket dish, candle holders and a vase
 - How to glaze your hand-built pieces and paint with underglazes
