About the course

Learn the essential skills for fashionable millinery and design your own fascinator using a traditional base and your imagination! This is the season for wild and beautiful hats, and you can let yourself inspire by creations for weddings and the races. You will also learn creative ways to upcycle and recycle everyday items and materials to create affordable and unique hats.

What will I learn?

- Design and make your own hat desgin
- Use ordinary household items or recycle waste materials to create new materials and forms
- Discuss wearability and how to make a fascinator steady on your head for a day out.

What are the entry requirements?

• This course is suitable for beginners with little or no previous knowledge of millinery or crafts. However, to access this course basic digital skills are essential.

What do I need to bring with me?

- This is an online course please see the 'Devices and Digital Applications Required for Online Courses' section below
- We will provide you with a fascinator base. You will need to provide other materials, and will be guided on this in your first session.
- You may wish to bring a piece of paper and a pen to take notes.

How will my learning be assessed?

This is a non-accredited course with the intent to benefit lifelong learning. Your tutor will give you regular verbal and written feedback to support your progression. You will submit your course work and track your learning in Google Classroom. You will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.

To successfully complete the course your attendance should be a minimum of 85% and course work should be completed by the end of the course.

Devices and digital applications required for online courses

This is an interactive online course which requires access to a good internet connection and a device with a camera and microphone. We recommend that you download Google Chrome browser if using a laptop or PC. For tablets and smartphones, we recommend you download the Google Meet and Google Classroom apps.

We use Google Suite for Education. If you are a new learner with us, we will create an account for you. Details will be sent to your personal email so please check your inbox and spam regularly prior to course start.
