

Support Teaching and Learning in Schools and Colleges Level 2 Certificate

About the Course

This is a 16-week **progression** course follows the completion of the Support Work in Schools and Colleges Award. This qualification shares mandatory units with the above award and therefore provides opportunities for direct progression towards achieving the support teaching and learning in schools and colleges certificate.

Learners need to be working or volunteering in a practical placement in Hounslow for a minimum of 5 hours per week for the duration of the course in a learning environment (school or college under 19 years), as they will need to demonstrate competence in both skills and knowledge. These arrangements must be made before enrolling and learners must produce a confirmation letter from the placement when they enrol.

- Contribute to teamwork in a learning environment.
- Equality, diversity, and inclusion in a learning environment for children and young people
- Maintain relationships with children and young people.
- Support the health and safety of children and young people.
- Support positive behaviour in a learning environment for children and young people.
- Understand children and young people's play and leisure.
- Promote an effective learning environment.
- Provide displays in a learning environment.

Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

What is needed for the course?

- You will need an initial assessment, where we will ask you to complete some tasks.
- We will also ask you some questions to be able to support you better with your studies.
- You need to have writing skills at English Level 1 or above.
- You will need to have a confirmed placement in the Hounslow Borough
- You will need internet access and an electronic device.
