

Early Years Practitioner Level 2 Diploma

What will I learn on this course?

This 35-week qualification is ideal for learners looking to work with children between birth and 5 years and gain knowledge of working with children up to 7 years. The 14 units are as follows:

- Roles and responsibilities of the EYP
- Health and safety of babies and young children in the early years
- Equality, diversity and inclusive practice in Early Years Settings
- Safeguarding, protection and welfare of babies and young children in Early Years Settings
- Understand how to support children's development
- Support care routines for babies and young children
- Support the planning and delivery of activities, purposeful play opportunities and educational programmes
- Promote play in an Early Years Setting
- Support well-being of babies and young children for healthy lifestyles
- Support babies and young children to be physically active
- Support the needs of babies and young children with Special Educational Needs and Disability
- Promote positive behaviour in Early Years Settings
- Partnership working in the early years
- Support the needs of the child in preparing for school

<u>Please note</u>: To successfully complete this course, you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

What do I need to do to achieve this course?

- You will need an initial assessment, where we will ask you to complete some tasks.
- We will also ask you some questions to be able to support you better with your studies.
- You need to have writing skills at English Level 1 or above.
- You must be working or volunteering in an early year's environment (children under 5 years) for a minimum of 8 hours per week so that you can be assessed. For example: nursery/preschool/early year setting following the early years curriculum.
- The arrangements should be made with an organisation in the Hounslow area. The arrangements must be made before enrolment.
