- Use interfacing to stiffen fabric
- Sew triangular and square corners
- Make a pouch with a pressed crease closing

What is required to attend the course?

Material:

- o **Fabric, 30cm x 60cm** (preferably plain cotton weave, mid- to heavy-weight)
- o Fabric for lining, 30cm x 60cm (preferably plain cotton weave, light- to mid-weight)
- o Fusible interfacing, 30cm x 60cm (preferably heavy-weight)
- Matching sewing thread
- 2 Magnets and super glue (not necessary, but will make your bag snap close)
- Basic sewing kit (Measuring tape, Scissors, Pins, Unpicker, Sewing needle, Ruler, Iron, Chalk/Marker)
- Sewing machine is not necessary to attend this course, but very useful.

Technical Requirements for our Online Courses:

- Access to the internet with camera and microphone.
- You must know how to independently access Google Suite Apps access to a Chrome Browser or Download Phone Apps to access Google Meet, Google Classroom and Google Docs.
