About the course

This course is part of our Family Learning Programmes. There are two types of Family Learning Programmes, FEML and WFL, and this course is part of our FEML offer.

FEML Programmes are aimed to give parents and carers the opportunity to find out how things are taught in their children's schools, as well as a chance to share ideas with other parents and develop their own knowledge and skills. (*for WFL course please see our WFL programme offer)

On this course you will learn about the educational system in England from birth to University - including how to support your child with a student loan application. We will discuss and share both vocational routes as well as the traditional academic routes (A-levels to University and T-levels). We will also look at the assessment process throughout your child's schools such as SATS assessments and what this means to you and your child.
