You will need to provide proof of income, for example, this could be a wage slip within 3 months of the course start date, or a current employment contract, which states gross monthly/annual wages.

About the course

This course is part of our creative art specialist programme designed to enable learners to develop their practice in visual arts. The course is aimed for beginners or artists in the early stages of their practice. The course will give you a solid foundation for further courses in drawing, painting or other creative art subjects.

On this course you will be introduced to the fundamental elements and principles of visual art, through theory and practice. In each session you will be introduced to a different visual component, and apply this in a drawing or painting exercise.

What will I learn?

After this course you will be able to:

- Name and apply the fundamental **elements** of visual art
- Know of the fundamental principles of visual art

What are the entry requirements?

- This course is suitable for beginners, or for learners who wants to strengthen their fundamental knowledge of visual arts
- We use Google Suite for Education to record your learning journey. If you are a new learner with us, we will create an account for you. Details will be sent to your personal email so please check your inbox and spam regularly prior to course start.

What do I need to bring with me?

- Sketchpad (size A4 or A3)
- Pencils, eraser, sharpener
- You might wish to bring colours and paints, but all necessary resources will be provided

How will my learning be assessed?

Your tutor will give you regular verbal and feedback to support your progression. will participate in group discussions and receive guidance.
