

GCSE Mathematics

About the Course

Start Date: September 2026 **End Date:** June 2027

Course Length: 2 sessions of 2 hours each per week over 29 weeks.

The course is in the physical environment.

You will need to pass three GCSE Maths exams; two calculator and one non-calculator exam. The qualification is accredited by AQA.

There is approximately 4 hours of homework per week.

Course Learning Outcomes

- Develop the skills needed to answer questions across a range of topics. You will focus on Number, Algebra, Geometry and measures, Probability and Statistics. You will sit three separate papers in which content from any part of the specification may be assessed.

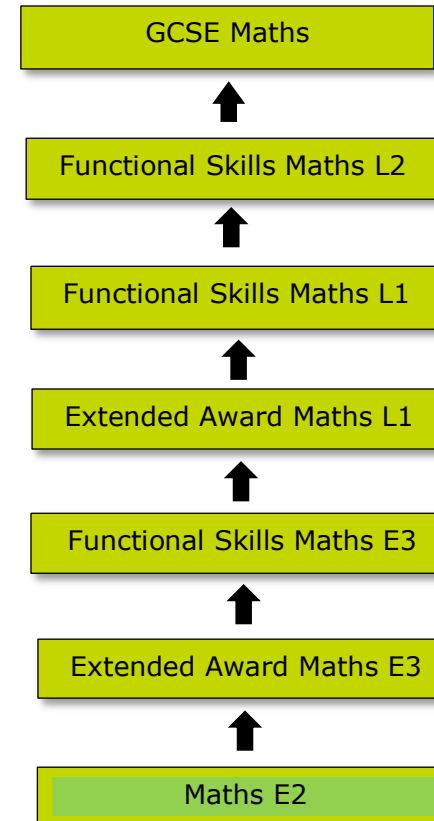
Please note: To successfully complete this course you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.
