What is required to attend the course?

- Material: Fabric that is similar to the quality of your garment, matching sewing thread, details such as interfacing/zippers/buttons if applicable. Baking sheet on roll (or pattern paper).
- Basic Sewing Kit. Pen and paper for note taking. Sewing machines are preferred but not essential.
