About the course

This course is part of our Family Learning Programmes. There are two types of Family Learning Programmes, FEML and WFL, and this course is part of our FEML offer.

FEML Programmes are aimed to give parents and carers the opportunity to find out how things are taught in their children's schools, as well as a chance to share ideas with other parents and develop their own skills. (*for WFL course please see our WFL programme offer)

The intent of this course is to support parents and carers to understand the advantages and risks of the Internet on their children's development and develop strategies to eliminate these risks.

What will I learn?

- Uderstand how parental controls can be used to advice on sexting, online games and video apps to keep your child safe

How will my learning be assessed?
