## Hounslow Adult & Community Education Course Information Sheet

**Course Title:** Caring for Children Level 1 - Award

**Start Date:** September 2020

**End Date:** February 2021

**Course Length:** 2 sessions per week over 16 weeks on a Thursday and Friday afternoon.

**Time:** (90 mins Live session on Google Meet and 30 minutes in Google Classroom for questions, feedback and assignments)

You will track your progress by accessing your online learning plan (ILP), from the start to the end of the course. You will respond to questions and feedback in the Google Classroom.

You will build a portfolio to provide the evidence necessary to achieve the qualification which is accredited by Cache.

There is approximately 2-4 hours of homework per week.

The first four weeks of the course will give you an opportunity to see how you feel about learning this way. You can see how well you are keeping up with the work and whether the course is providing you with the right level of challenge. It will also be a time for us to evaluate whether we think this is the right course for you or whether a different course would be more suitable.

### **By the end of the course you will be able to:**

- Access your learning through Google Classroom
- Become aware of your strengths and areas for development
- Develop your study skills
- Understand stages and influences on growth and development of children from birth to 5 years 11 months
- Recognise features of a positive learning environment and identify ways in which positive play activities can help children's learning and development
- Gain an understanding of respecting and valuing children and some knowledge of organisations that support children's rights
- Gain an understanding of health and safety requirements when with a young child

### **What is required to attend the course?**

- You will need an initial assessment.
- Access to internet with camera and microphone.
- You must know how to independently access Google Suite Apps - access to a Chrome Browser or Download Phone Apps to access Google Meet, Google Classroom and Google Docs.

- You need to have English skills at Entry Level 3 or above.

- Enrol onto another Adult Learning course, develop your Early Years knowledge further or develop your English skills further.
