What will I learn on this course?

This 35-week qualification is ideal for learners looking to work with children between birth and 5 years and gain knowledge of working with children up to 7 years.

- Promote health and wellbeing.
- Understand legislation, frameworks, and professional practice.
- Enable play, development and learning for school readiness.

The aim of this qualification is to prepare you to become an early year's practitioner to work with children from birth to seven years.

Please note: To successfully complete this course, you must commit to 100% attendance and punctuality.

What do I need to do to achieve this course?

You will need an initial assessment, where we will ask you to complete some tasks.

We will also ask you some questions to be able to support you better with your studies.

You need to have writing skills at English Level 1 or above.

You **must** be working or volunteering in an early year's environment in the Hounslow Borough with (children under 5 years) for a minimum of 8 hours per week so that you can be assessed. Nursery/preschool/early year setting following the **early years curriculum**.

The arrangements should be made with an organisation before enrolment and proof of placement be available to view at the time of enrolment.

Equipment / resources You will need to purchase a notebook and pen. You will need to have an electronic device such as a mobile phone, laptop, or tablet.
